





The County of Granville

The Orphans' Friend and Masonic Journal December 15, 1922

One of 32 Counties Still Existing Which Were Formed Before 1776 Fred A. Olds

"Born to Edgecombe county, July, 1746, a county named Granville and the Parish of St. John", could have been written of the creation of the latter county. The act of Assembly says, "Whereas, the County and Parish of Edgecombe, being a Frontier county, is now so extensively settled that the Public Business and said County and Parish becomes very difficult to be transacted, now, therefore, be it enacted, that the County and Parish be divided and that the upper part be erected into a county by the name of Granville and St John's Parish; that the justices of Granville hold their first court at the dwelling house of William EATON and then select a certain place for building the court house, prison, and stocks; to run the dividing line; and to pay the cost by levying a poll tax not exceeding 2 shillings Proclamation money per year for 2 years and no longer; William EATON, William PERSON, Francis STONIGER and James MACKLEWEAN are appointed commissioners to run a line between Granville and Johnston; William EATON, William PERSON, John MARTIN, Edward JONES, James MITCHELL, James PAYNE, West HARRIS, John WADE, William MOORE, Samuel LANIER, Robert PARKER and Joseph SIMS are appointed vestrymen of St. John's Parish, to serve until the general election of vestrymen, and the said vestrymen shall be summoned by the sheriff to meet at the house of William EATON, qualify themselves and proceed to the transaction of Parish business." (The county of Johnston and Parish of Saint Patrick was formed at the same time out of the western part of Craven.)

Granville county was named in honor of Earl GRANVILLE, one of whose ancestors, Sir George CARTERET, was one of the eight original Lords Proprietors of the Carolinas. In 1729 seven of the eight Lords Proprietors sold back to the King their parts, but Granville refused to do so and the King had no power to compel him, so for him was laid off his "eighth", all in North Carolina and embracing exactly half the 52,000 square miles of its area. This ownership caused, until the War of the Revolution ended in 1776, no end of trouble. His half of the Province of North Carolina, was in the northern part and was called "Granville's District", the southern half being known as the "King's District".

The first county seat of Granville was at Harrisburg (about two miles from the present Oxford) and there the court house and jail were built. The tax levied in 1746 was found not sufficient to build the court house, jail, etc., and in April, 1748, a further tax of 2 shillings on the poll, for two years, was ordered by the Assembly, and William EATON and Edward JONES were named as commissioners to complete the buildings. In October, 1748, the Assembly directed that the court house and jail should be "on or near the banks of Tar river at Tabb's creek" and that Edward JONES, William EATON, and Jonathan SMITH be commissioners to erect these buildings. The Assembly found that when the line was properly surveyed between Granville and its mother county of Edgecombe the court house location decided on in 1746 and again in April 1748, was within 6 or 7 miles of the northwest corner of Granville and hence improper. So the commissioners were directed to sell the incomplete court house and jail and apply the money to the erection of others at Tabb's creek.

In 1749 Rev. Clement **HALL**, a missionary, reported to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel in London, that he had "lately been on a long journey from Edenton to Granville county,

which lies westward, wherein I rode (on horseback) above 300 miles, preached 7 sermons, churched 50 well disposed women and baptized 184 children". Tobacco warehouses (that is storehouses) in which the leaf was deposited in payment of the county and parish tax levied (that is poll taxes) were provided. The price of tobacco was fixed by law. An official receiver took it. Most of it was shipped to England.

In September 1752, a notable pilgrimage was made through the county by the Good Moravian, Bishop **SPANGLEBURG**, who started from Edenton on his way to the piedmont region to take up 100 acres of land he had been granted on quit-rent leases (that is from year to year, as neither Lord Granville nor the King sold any land). September 25, 1752, he wrote from Granville county: "Edenton is one of the oldest towns in America, yet it is a quarter as large as Germantown, Pennsylvania. Tobacco is raised here in considerable quantities but is generally taken to Norfolk or Suffolk in Virginia, examined by the inspectors, all that is merchantable is selected, the remainder is burned! The Virginia merchants ship that which is fit and pay the farmers what they please for their tobacco. Large numbers of cattle are taken to Virginia and there slaughtered while the raiser suffers loss as he only gets paid for the meat after it is slaughtered, and for the tallow, hide, etc., the butcher pays him nothing. The same is the case with hogs, which are taken to Virginia, slaughtered, salted, exported and sold as Virginia pork in the West Indians and traded for rum, sugar, molasses, etc., which the North Carolinians buy, paying money for it.

"We are at Mr. SALIS' house, 153 miles from Edenton, and the land we have seen has nothing remarkable. There are large areas of pine barrens but these, we are told, have all been taken up. We find little done on the plantations except the raising of Indian corn and hogs. As to horses and cattle no care is given them during the winter. The horses are not much larger than English colts and their cows the size of our yearlings. Four of our company are here at John SALIS', sick of remittent fever, and are going through a severe sweating process, induced by a certain medicinal herb. There is not a navigable river in Lord GRANVILLE'S district.

"We are staying with a man who spent a year and a half in Africa. The captain with whom he sailed deserted him, the negroes captured and bound him with the intention of killing him, but set him free, treated him with kindness and would have gladly kept him with them but he sighed for his native land and availed himself of the first opportunity of returning here. He and his wife treat us with the greatest consideration and we pray that they may be abundantly recompensed. We go from here through Orange to Anson, which is the last county toward the west and where we will probably settle." (John SALIS in 1756 charged John PAINE, a member of the General Assembly, with many crimes.)

The good bishop gives in his quaint and direct way a valuable peep at the region. He speaks of a queer custom of the surveyors, who surveyed only three sides of any tract of land. The county of Orange was brand new, formed in 1752, out of parts of Granville, Johnston and Bladen. When the French war came in 1757, Robert **HARRIS** was commissioner for Granville, to furnish supplies to the friendly Indians who marched from South Carolina with the whites against the French and their Indian allies in western Pennsylvania.

The number of Granville militia in 1755 was 734, white taxables, 779 (males over 18 years of age), black taxables 426. In 1759 there were stirring events for many men rose against the extortion of Earl GRANVILLE'S agents and some for Granville went to Edenton, and aided in taking his chief agent, Francis CORBIN, a prisoner to Enfield, in Halifax county, and they also planned to petition

Granville court to "silence" Robert JONES, the attorney general of the Province and they made the direct threat if this was not done they would "pull JONES' nose and also abuse the court". It is interesting to know that Gov. **DOBBS** really "backed" the insurgents. (All this was the first outbreak of what was in the county of Orange and some others to become known as the Regulation, which began in 1768 and was put down by **TRYON** and his army of 2,550 men at the Battle of the Alamance in May, 1771. There were election riots in 1760, and "the sheriff could not take the poll for representatives in the Assembly.")

The third classical school of prominence in "upper Carolina" was that of Rev. Henry **PATILLO**, in Granville. He was a delegate in the Provincial Congress of North Carolina in 1775 from Bute county. He was a Presbyterian. Two other preachers were in this congress, one of them Green **HILL**, also from Bute.

Legendary Greens

The ritual of garnishing our homes with evergreen trees, wreaths, and garlands has existed for centuries. But why do we do it? Here are some hints at the history behind the greens that revive a bleak winter with a fresh breath of life.

Holly and Ivy

Believed by Romans, then Christians, to have protective powers, holly was used as a charm throughout the home – hence "deck the halls with boughs of holly".

An ancient symbol of love, full-flowing ivy is a natural companion to hard, prickly holly. Beginning in the Middle Ages, the English twined ivy around arrangements of berry-laden holly for a softening touch. The holly was thought male and the ivy female, with the pairing symbolizing a good-natured rivalry between the sexes.

Evergreen Trees

The custom of including an evergreen tree in the Christmas celebration dates back to the 16th century. Martin Luther was said to be strolling through the forest one Christmas Eve when he became awestruck by the splendor of the stars twinkling through the snowy tree branches. To him, the sight suggested the majesty and mystery of the starlit sky as it must have appeared that first Christmas in Bethlehem. Luther so wanted to share the experience with his children that he chopped down a snowy fir tree, carried it home, and decorated it with candles – the next best thing to starlight.

In 1605, a writer in the Alsace region of France was the first to document a decorated Christmas tree. He recorded how residents cut down fir trees, then dressed them up with apples, gold foil, paper roses, wafers, and sweets – decorations that have remained timeless.

A Christmas Pie

Make the walls of a thick standing crust, to any size you like and ornamented as fancy directs. Lay at the bottom of the pie a beef steak. Bone a turkey, goose, fowl, duck, partridge and place one over the other, so that when cut, the white and brown meat may appear alternately. Put a large tongue by its side, and fill the vacancies with forcemeat balls and hard eggs; then add savory jelly. This last is better for being kept in a mould and only taken out as required. Bacon, chopped or beat up with the forcemeat, is preferable to suet, as it is nicer when cold and keeps better.

Following herewith is a list of the tax payers in GRANVILLE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA for the year 1788. The territory covered by this list includes the present area of the county, plus the area embraced in the present VANCE COUNTY, which had not been established at the time the list was made. This list appears in Vol. 26 of the North Carolina Records and was used by the Federal Government as a substitute for the first census of 1790. As we have arranged these names in alphabetical order, they will not be included in the index. Where a note follows the name, of course, that is by this compiler. The initialed symbols after the name represents the DISTRICT where the assessment was made, but the person assessed had property in more than one district, which explains why the same name is sometimes repeated. The Districts and symbols were as follows:



Some Old Oxford Families Oxford Public Ledger, October 20, 1953

With a Few Historical and Genealogical Notes Concerning a Number of Their Members, Including Several References to the Youngest Generation By Francis B. Hayes

Taylors, An Old and Numerous Family

Some of the **TAYLORS** are among the oldest families in Oxford, Nathaniel M. **TAYLOR** having been a member of the town's first board of commissioners in 1816. His brother, Rev. Lewis Nathaniel **TAYLOR**, was pastor of the Oxford Episcopal Church in 1841-44.

Henry Alley **TAYLOR**, a son of Rev. Lewis Nathaniel **TAYLOR** lived on the Wilton road just beyond the Colored Orphanage. His son Thomas George **TAYLOR** also lived and brought up a large family there. One of his sons is Archibald Lenox **TAYLOR**, who now lives at the old **TAYLOR** place. Mrs. Hoyle **BEAM**, daughter of Archibald Lenox **TAYLOR**, and her children sojourn occasionally at the **TAYLOR** homestead and these children are of the sixth generation from Rev. Lewis Nathaniel **TAYLOR**.

There are now in Oxford, and much of the rest of the country a host of great-great-grandchildren of Archibald **TAYLOR** and of his brother, Dr. Leonidas C. **TAYLOR**, two old Oxford residents. Some of these children of the fifth generation are the great-grandchildren of Mrs. Lucy Taylor **FORT**, of Mrs. Mildred **TAYLOR**, and of Robert Perry **TAYLOR**. Other of these fifth-generation children are the great-grandchildren of William Robert **TAYLOR**, Mrs. Lena Taylor **HINES**, James Archibald **TAYLOR**, and Richard Pelham **TAYLOR**. To name and identify all the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of the seven **TAYLOR** sons and daughters here mentioned would prolong this article unduly; indeed, would require a good long separate article.

Several Osborn Descendants But Only One Osborn Now Living In Oxford

Another of Oxford's oldest families are **OSBORNS**. The grandchildren of the late James A. **OSBORN**, whose body was buried from his home on Military Street a few weeks ago, are of the sixth generation from Jonathan **OSBORN**, who once lived in – and probably built – the present Miss Georgia **WINSTON** house. Some of the **OSBORNS** of a later generation also have lived in that house.

The MARRIOTT children, grandchildren of Mrs. Ira HOWARD, are of the fifth generation from Jonathan OSBORN.

The **CHEATHAM** twins, Graham and Gordon, are of the fourth generation from that same old Oxford patriarch, and the children of Gordon are of the fifth.

Henry T. OSBORN, great-grandson of Jonathan, is the only OSBORN now residing here.

Landis Name Dates Back A Long Way In Granville and Oxford History

Augustine LANDIS was prominent in Granville's official circles during a large part of the nineteenth century. He was a son of George LANDIS of the southern end of the county and came to Oxford as a young man. He was coroner for a while and then became clerk of the county court in 1849. He held that office until it was abolished by the constitution of 1868, when he became deputy clerk of the superior court, and later was clerk of the old inferior court until his death, May 25, 1879.

Augustine LANDIS had four sons, all brave Confederate soldiers, on of whom, Augustus, was captain of the Granville Grays. Captain LANDIS married three times and had fifteen children to reach maturity. His eldest son was Charles Hamlin LANDIS, whose daughter Lucy, married Franklin Wills HANCOCK, Jr. The HANCOCKS have several children and grandchildren, the latter being of the sixth generation from Augustine LANDIS.

The **HANCOCK** grandchildren, through Mrs. Lizzie Hobgood **HANCOCK**, are also of the fifth generation from Dr. Franklin P. **HOBGOOD**, president of Oxford College, who died February 6, 1924.

Mrs. Mamie Hobgood **ROYSTER**, another daughter of Dr. **HOBGOOD**, has children, sons and daughters, some of whom have made her several times a grandmother. The children of these grandchildren are of course of the fifth generation from Dr. **HOBGOOD**.

Mrs. Cameron Herndon EASTON, also a daughter of Charles Hamlin LANDIS, is the mother of Cameron Herndon EASTON, Jr., who is of the fifth generation from Augustine LANDIS and Dr. John Rhodes HERNDON, and the seventh from Thomas HICKS.

William Thorpe LANDIS, son of Charles Hamlin LANDIS, is grandfather of children who are of the sixth generation from Augustine LANDIS. On his mother's side William Thorpe LANDIS has many generations of distinguished THORPE and GREGORY ancestors, many of whom lived in Granville but not in Oxford.

Jordans and Powells

Rev. William Hill **JORDAN** was pastor of the Oxford Baptist Church for a period shortly before the Civil War and a long-time resident of Oxford, where he died October 12, 1883. His daughter, Lucy, married Charles G. **POWELL** and was the great-grandmother of several **POWELL** children, who are of the fifth generation from Mr. **JORDAN**. The children of Sholar **POWELL** are of the sixth generation.

Charles Alexander GREGORY, the elder, was the father of the late Mrs. James B. POWELL, and the grandfather of James B. POWELL, Jr., and so, with the Sholar POWELL children makes five generations.

The Herndons Were Among Oxford's Most Prominent Families

Dr. John Rhodes **HERNDON**, a practicing physician, lived in the house now serving as the **PITTARD**-VAUGHT Funeral Home. That house has been turned from Main Street to Littlejohn Street to make way for the present post-office building, first opened for business July 3, 1913. Dr. **HERNDON** was of the family of **HERNDONS** which owned much of the most valuable real estate in Oxford as well as farm lands adjoining Oxford and elsewhere in the county. His daughter, Sally, married Henry P. **EASTON** and this couple were the parents of Mrs. Anna Easton **PARHAM**, Charles Skinner **EASTON**, and Cameron Herndon **EASTON**. Mrs. **PARHAM** was the mother of Easton **PARHAM**, whose grandchildren are of the sixth generation from Dr. John Rhodes **HERNDON**.

Dorseys A Widespread Family

Dr. Washington **DORSEY** practiced medicine in Oxford and the county prior to the Civil War. A house in which he lived, on the east side of the Durham highway a few miles from town, was demolished not so many years ago. It was a weather-beaten structure, part one-story and part two-story. Dr. **DORSEY** had a large family. A daughter, Virginia, married Col. Rush Johnson **MITCHELL** and they were the parents of Mrs. Emma Mitchell **BRITT**, mother of Mrs. Charlotte Britt **HOBBS**, who is now prominent in the social, religious, financial, literary, etc., circles of Oxford.

Another **MITCHELL** daughter was Lydia (Lillie) who married Joseph N. LYON. Their daughter, Mrs. A. A. FARRALL, now lives in Washington, D.C., and has grandchildren who are of the sixth generation from Dr. **DORSEY**.

A third **MITCHELL** daughter is Mrs. Nannie Mitchell **COLLINS**, now living in Washington, D.C., at an advanced age. She has a number of descendants. Her husband, Thomas H. **COLLINS**, with John T. **BRITT**, bought of **VENABLE & PASCHALL** the News of Oxford and changed its name to The Oxford Public Ledger. This deal is mentioned elsewhere in this article under Abram Watkins **VENABLE**.

Dr. DORSEY had a daughter, Cecelia Elizabeth, who married Thomas M. LYNCH and was the mother of Mrs. Mary Lynch BULLOCK, who in turn was mother of Frank BULLOCK, father of Frank BULLOCK, Jr., of the fifth generation from Dr. DORSEY.

Howard **DORSEY** was a son of Dr. **DORSEY**. He had a son, William Edward **DORSEY**, who was father of Howard **DORSEY**, who lives on the Henderson highway three or four miles from Oxford. This younger Howard **DORSEY** has two sons, Melville Howard **DORSEY** and Ronald Sherman **DORSEY**, of the fifth generation from Dr. **DORSEY**.

A daughter, Cynthia, of William Edward **DORSEY**, married Luther W. **STARK**, Jr. Mrs. **STARK** as mentioned under Richard T. **SMITH**, has a **SMITH** granddaughter who is of the sixth generation from Dr. **DORSEY**.

Mrs. Hampton LONGMIRE, the former Elizabeth DORSEY, proprietor of Hamp's Tavern on the Henderson highway near Tabb's Creek, is a daughter of William Edward DORSEY, and so a great-granddaughter of Dr. Howard DORSEY.

Mrs. Wallis **WARFIELD**, the present Duchess of Windsor, to marry whom King Edward VIII abdicated the British throne, was of the **DORSEY** family of Maryland as was Dr. **DORSEY**, who came to North Carolina from that state via Virginia.
