

I have been trying to determine who my g-g-grandfather's (Walter E Cottrell) parents are for years. The below information lists the details of what I know, and I am including a list of documents I have been able to locate for Walter. Maybe you can offer advice on where to turn to next? I feel like I have done all I can online and through my parents; now I need to see what is available to me elsewhere. My geographical distance from NC is preventing me from popping into the library or the courthouses (although I wish I could!).

My father is: Larry Taylor Cottrell b. 19 Mar 1941, Oxford, Granville Co, NC. (living)

My paternal grandparents are: Wilson Taylor Cottrell b. 20 Jul 1918, Oak Hill, Granville Co, NC d. 27 Jul 1963, Brooklyn, Kings Co, NY

Mackie Serene Averett b. 27 Aug 1918, Sampson, NC d. 1 Nov 1990, Dunn, Harnett, NC

Wilson's parents are: Alfred Edrith Cottrell b. 24 Mar 1898, Granville Co. NC d. 13 May 1990, Chase City, Mecklenburg, VA

Lavenia (Venie) Cole (2nd marriage was to Willie Surratt) b. 27 Jul 1896, VA d. 3 Nov 1977 VA

Records I have for Alfred: Censuses in 1900, 1910, 1920, 1930, NC Birth Index, SSDI, WWI Draft Registration. Records I have for Venia: Censuses in 1900, 1910, 1920, 1930, SSDI, Obituary (High Point Enterprise, NC).

Records I have for Walter are: Censuses 1880, 1900, 1910, 1920, NC Death Collection, NC Death Certificate. Details:

1880 Census, Townsville, Granville, NC. In this census, Walter is listed as "nephew" with head of household David T(homas) Cottrell (b. 1853 d. 1926). David's spouse is Elizabeth (Turner) Cottrell (b. 1854 d. 1893). They have one child in the household in addition to Walter: Richard T. Cottrell (b. 1880 d. 1939)

1900 Census, Pleasant Grove Township, Johnston, NC. In this census Walter is married to Ada (Dixon) Cottrell. They are married 5 years.

1910 Census, Oak Hill, Granville, NC. 1920 Census, Oak Hill, Granville, NC

North Carolina Death Certificate - Walter's parents are listed as "not known," although it states his parents were both born in Granville County, NC. The informant is Reuben Hart. I have not been able to determine his connection to Walter.

Records I have for Ada are:

Censuses in 1880, 1900, 1910, 1920, 1930, NC Death Certificates, NC Death Collection.

Since Walter is listed as David's nephew in the 1880 census, I am including the information I have gathered about David's family as follows:

David's parents: Matthew Cottrell b. about 1812, NC d. about 1859

Happy Loyd (Floyd?) b. about 1822, NC d. 28 Feb 1923 (I am unsure where I collected this date).

Matthew and Happy were married 4 Dec 1841 (Granville County marriage records)

David's siblings (other children of Happy and Matthew):
Lucy Amy Cottrell (1844-1900)
Nancy Ann Cottrell (1845-?)
Mollie A Cottrell (1848 - 1928)
Polly Ann Cottrell (1851-1900)
-->David (1853-1926)
James Cottrell (1855-?)
Elizabeth Betty Cottrell (1858-?)

I am not positive about the children of Matthew and Happy for two reasons:

- 1. The Cottrell children seem to move among households between census dates (from parents to aunts/uncles)
- The 1850 census lists Happy and Matthew twice, and with different children listed at each location (Island Creek and Abrahams Planes). This is an unresolved mystery.

In 1870 there is a Jennette Cottrell who is listed as Happy's daughter, living in the household with Happy and Nancy. I surmise that this Jennette Cottrell is actually Nancy's daughter, not Happy's daughter. I believe this for two reasons:

1. Happy's spouse, Matthew, is deceased by 1870.

I find a Nancy Cottrell listed in the bastardy bonds the same year Jennette was born. One of the bondsman happens to be their "next door neighbor" in the 1870 census.

If it is of any help, Jennette Cottrell (1866-1919) married Daniel Hunter Norwood (1863-1913) around 1888.

I would truly appreciate any assistance you can offer. As you may have surmised, my Dad's family relocated to NY when my Dad was very young; I now live in CT, so we are not close to the libraries and court houses in NC. If I know who to contact I'll gladly write letters. It is my dream to someday visit Granville County and solve some long time family mysteries.

Thank you in advance for taking the time to read and respond.
