

Now, mind you, the families found below are not mine, and I am not going to do a descendant or relationship chart for the people listed this information.

I was reading through the vertical files in the North Carolina room at the Richard H Thornton Library and I happened into the Dorsey file. Now Dorsey is a name I recognize from Maryland and in looking through the letter I also saw that it referenced Howard County which I also recognized.

So I made a copy of the letter and brought it home. I read through the letter, puzzling over some of the handwriting and then I decided I would transcribe it to see what information it had

Having done that, I found I was curious about the relationships of the people mentioned in the letter. There were several unusual given names but thankfully the author of the letter signed her full name: Mary Huntington Lynch.

I put her name as a search term into the database for Genealogybank.com and it pulled up a number of records. I opened one of these and found the name of the author of the letter in the contents of the newspaper from the Baltimore Sun and the record also gave information about the other relatives mentioned in the letter.

Apparently a woman named Lantz had submitted a lot of information on the Dorsey family which was published by the Baltimore Sun. Readers of the newspaper wrote to the editor to submit their own information and how it supplemented the information by Ms. Lantz. The letter I looked at was one of these responses. So if you're interested in the Dorsey family, there's more information on other lines.

The other thing I looked at was information from FamilySearch.org. In databases there, I found 2 births for Mary Huntington Lynch and William Battle Bullock as parents.

- 1. Frank William Bullock born 21 September 1910 Granville Co., NC.
- 2. Washington Lynch Bullock born 7 January 1913 Granville Co., NC.

So here it is now for you to read. The letter was written in 1900 and the record from the Baltimore Sun is from 1908.

If I questioned the spelling it will show as [sic]; if I could not read the letters at all I would put [?].

Oxford, NC

May 16, 1900

My dear Ethel

Your letter just received am glad to tell you anything I know which is but little, the book I have

tells nothing about the Civil War and what it does mention is about the Northern side the Dorsey's and Howard's being mostly northern sympathy.

Uncle Washington as you know was with General Pettigrew and fought through the Battle of Gettysburg, and when the General was wounded was among those who protected the rear in the retreat across the Potomac. Uncle Washington's Regiment as of course uncle Melville can tell you was the 47th.

Uncle Thompson Seabrook's 2 sons were killed at Shiloh the same day. Their names were John and Edward. I don't know their Regiment after their deaths poor uncle Thompson turned Guerilla. Cousin Seabrook Sheppard (aunt Sallie now[?]) lives in Texas and with the Texas Rangers and was never heard of after the war as was the same with so many.

General Mosby was a near kinsmen of grandma.

Cousin William Burgess was the only nephew on the Dorsey side for most of the connection took a significantly if not active part with the North. Of course Uncle Howard and Uncle Washington were two good Southerners. When you come to the wedding, we may be able to find out some more. You should certainly feel at home in anything given for the DAR for Howard County alone furnished 300 able bodied men for the revolution from the Dorsey family. I am so sorry Laurine[?] has been sick. I believe there is to be a lunch at Mrs. Cannady's when Wade is married. I always dread being a bridesmaid, though I appreciate anyone asking me to be one but I were[?] so terrible to be at all conspicuous. And Emma is much better I am glad to say. I feel so bad myself I don't know what to do. Margaret is going home tomorrow but I reckon brother has let uncle Melville know. Aunt Emma sends much love to all.

My love to Uncle Melville and Aunt Minnie [could be Nannie] Laurine and yourself not forgetting little Elizabeth.

Yours affectionately Mary Huntington Lynch

The book I have gives me no information that will be of assistance for it tells things about colonial and revolutionary days. I wish so much I didn't know a good deal to tell you. I am afraid we could find many more kinsmen in the GAR than in the CSA at best.

19 April 1908 Baltimore Sun volume CXLII, issue 155 page 18. Messrs. Editors:

Inclosed[sic] you will find a record of the descendants of Dr. Washington Dorsey. I hope it would not be too late for publication in connection with Miss Lantz's very interesting articles in your highly valued paper. This would have been prepared and sent sooner, but was prevented by sickness and death in my family. Very truly,

Oxford NC Mrs. E Dorsey L.

Miss Lantz in her history of the Dorsey family of Maryland makes mention of but one son of Lloyd and Anne (Green) Dorsey, and that is William Dorsey, my uncle who lived in Martinsburg, Virginia. My father Dr. Washington Dorsey, third son of Lloyd and Anne (Green) Dorsey, was graduated in his profession in Baltimore in 1830 or 1831. He then left Maryland, came to Rockbridge County, Virginia, where in the same year he married Camilla Yerrill Seabrook, daughter of Capt. John Seabrook, formally of Richmond, VA, and Nancy Sydnor, of Dungaarven, Hanover County, VA.

After making their home in Virginia for a few years they emigrated to what was then considered the "backwoods" of North Carolina. They settled at Wilton, Granville County, where for more than 25 years my father successfully practice his profession. In 1864, worn by privations and anxieties of the Civil War, he contracted fever from his patients, from which he died September 22, leaving his wife, who died October 3, 1882, and 9 children: 1) Virginia Ann 2) Cecilia Elizabeth 3) Mary Green 4) Washington, Jr. 5) Emma Seabrook 6) Howard 7) Seabrook 8) Edward Garland 9) Melville. Virginia Ann Dorsey married Maj. R J Mitchell, of the Mexican and Confederate armies. Virginia (Dorsey) Mitchell died in 1894; Maj. R J Mitchell, in 1897 [?]. Children: 1) Charlotte Virginia, who married George W Bobbs of New York, formally of Howard County, Maryland. "GRANDFATHER CLAUSE" VOTING REGISTRATIONS FOR GRANVILLE COUNTY

What is the "grandfather clause" and how does it relate to the Native American/"free colored" citizens of Granville County?

Let's jump right in!

The Grandfather Clause was an important component of the 1900 constitutional amendment restricting North Carolina's class of eligible voters. The disfranchisement amendment provided that voters must be able to read and write a section of the state constitution in the English language and to pay a poll tax. Far from attempting to encourage literacy, however, the primary goal of the amendment, as admitted in the Democratic Party's pro-amendment campaign in 1900, was to eliminate African American voters as a factor in North Carolina politics. The large number of poor illiterate black males, as well as the bias of white Democratic registrars, ensured that the literacy test and the poll tax would be used to reduce the electorate.

The drafters of the amendment were aware of the politically unacceptable fact that illiterate whites could also be excluded by the literacy test. The answer to this problem was the grandfather clause, which stated that no one should be denied the right to register and vote because of the literacy requirement if he or a lineal ancestor could vote under the law of his state of residence on 1 Jan. 1867, provided that he registered before 1 Dec. 1908. The 1867 date was important because it preceded any federal prohibition of racial discrimination; therefore very few blacks were eligible to vote. In practical terms, it meant that illiterate whites were absolved of the embarrassment of a literacy requirement and blacks were not, thus enhancing the discretionary power of Democratic registrars.

"Free people of color" in North Carolina had the right to vote and hold office until 1835, when North Carolina adopted a new constitution that disenfranchised ALL free people of color. With the new state

constitution enacted in 1900, North Carolina adopted a policy of "poll taxes" which essentially made it impossible for people of color to vote. As you read in the above summary, these poll taxes also made it difficult for "poor whites" to vote because many were illiterate and could not afford to pay the poll tax. As a result, North Carolina adopted a "grandfather clause" starting in 1900 which allowed for men to list themselves or a direct lineal male ancestor who could vote on January 1, 1867 (or earlier). By identifying themselves or an earlier direct ancestor as an eligible voter in 1867, these individuals were exempt from the poll tax.

Free people of color and those descended from free people of color took advantage of this grandfather clause in order to circumvent these literacy tests that were required to become an eligible voter. African Americans descended from slaves however were unable to take advantage of this grandfather clause because their ancestors for the most part were not eligible voters on January 1, 1867 (or earlier). However, free people of color had ancestors who were eligible voters in earlier times, so this grandfather clause provided a way to become registered to vote.

In 1902, 1904, 1906, and 1908, residents of Granville County who were eligible for the "grandfather clause" registered to vote. These lists are available to researchers for every county in the North Carolina State Archives in Raleigh. A fellow researcher and friend, Dr. Warren Milteer, provided me with un-transcribed copies of the Granville County list. A huge thanks to Dr. Milteer for sharing this incredibly valuable information. Not only do these lists provide the names of all who applied for the "grandfather clause", they are also helpful genealogical documents since individuals named earlier direct ancestors. The voter lists are a great way to verify suspected earlier ancestors of the person you're researching. And if you hit a genealogical road block, these lists may help you push through to identify an earlier ancestor.

WORD OF CAUTION: Just like all historical documents, you may find both intentional and unintentional errors in these documents. So they should be seen as just one of many clues to help you identify earlier ancestors. I have noticed a couple of errors in the lists for Granville County. For example, Hawkins Kersey (also known as Hawkins Tyler) listed his adopted father Baldy Kersey as a direct ancestor. Baldy Kersey was most definitely known as Hawkins' "father", but was not his biological father. Another example is found with Sandy Guy. On every census, marriage, and death record, Sandy is consistently identified as "Sandy Guy". However on his voter registration, he listed himself as "Sandy Chavis". I have no idea why he used a different surname for his voting application but I can assure you that Sandy Chavis = Sandy Guy.

Below is a table chart which lists all free people of color (and those descended from people of color) in Granville County who registered to vote using the "grandfather clause". I only transcribed the records for free people of color, so this list does not reflect all people who applied using the "grandfather clause". The first column is the name of the applicant, the second column is their listed age, the third column is the ancestor they claimed descent from, and the fourth column is the township they resided in. I added an additional column where I provided my own research notes to help you identify exactly who these individuals are. As you will see there are a couple of individuals who I'm still working on researching. I will update this list if I come across additional information. Also please note that this list is only for Granville County. Many people within the Granville County Native American community lived in Kittrell and Henderson townships and those townships became apart of Vance County in 1881. Therefore residents of those townships will be found in the Vance County list. What you will notice is a

heavy concentration of individuals living in Fishing Creek township which is where most of the community resided.

On a personal note, I was very delighted to see my great-great grandfather James E Howell registered to vote. I hope this information is valuable to your research.

Just Who is Buried on Indian Grave Hill?

[This article was first published, Feb 1998, in The Wheeler Family Newsletter, edited by Frances S. Wheeler.]

In Dec 1997, eleven graves, including the graves of Benjamin Wheeler, Jr. and his wife, Elizabeth Robertson, were moved from and old Wheeler cemetery off W.B. Clark Road, near Creedmoor, to the C.C. Wheeler Cemetery on Joe Peed Road. With the moving of the graves from the old Wheeler cemetery, speculation has arisen over where the graves of Benjamin and Winifred (Turner) Wheeler, parents of Benjamin Wheeler, Jr., might be. From available records it appears both parents died just after 1830. It was not hard to determine where they were living in 1830. Determining where their graves are may be impossible.

Moses Jones, Jr. and Dicey Wheeler Were issued a marriage bond in Granville Co., N.C. on 11 May 1799. In 1828, Benjamin Wheeler, Sr. gave his land on Ledge of Rocks Creek and all his worldly goods to his son-in-law, Moses Jones. A short time later Moses Jones sold the land to his brother-in-law, Benjamin Wheeler, Jr.

The parents of Moses Jones, Jr. were William Jones, Jr. and his wife, Ailsey's surname is unknown. When William Jones, Jr. died in 1818 he owned a piece of property referred to as "the Indian grave tract." He also owned several other pieces of property but this was his home place and is probably the site of his grave.

William Jones' "home place" is located on Old Hwy 75, at Butner. Today that piece of property is called "Indian Grave Hill." Going toward Stem it would be on the right side of the road at the top of a hill where the fire tower is standing. There is an old, old cemetery just behind the fire tower. There are a lot of graves in this cemetery, all

marked with field stones. I did not see a one of the graves has any name or date on it. The North Carolina State Archeologist said this appeared to be a two or three family cemetery.

Before 1850 only the head of household was named on the Federal Census. When the 1830 Granville County census was taken, Moses Jones, Jr. was listed as a head of household. In his household was a 20-30 year old unknown male, a 40-50 year old male (Moses Jones) and a 70-80 year old male (presumably Benjamin Wheeler, Sr.). Also in the household was a 40-50 year old female (Moses' wife, Dicy Wheeler Jones) and a 60-70 year old female (presumably Winifred Turner Wheeler).

To determine where Moses Jones was living I went to the Granville County deed books to see if he had bought land. Moses Jones had bought three different pieces of land. In 1807, Moses Jones bought 228 acres from his father, William Jones, Jr. He probably did not live on this property as he sold part of it to William Washington in 1811 and the rest to Edward Jones in 1813. In 1817, he bought a one acre strangely configured piece of property from Levin Cary. I suspect this was to be his "home place." In 1821, he bought 104 adjoining acres on the East side of Nap of Reeds Creek from Frances Worsham. Then in 1828, he bought another 104 adjoining acres from his son-in-law, Robert Francis Paul Jones, son of Robert and Mary (Gooch) Jones.

As is the case with a lot of old deeds, the metes and bounds were not very good on some of these deeds. To plot deeds I use the computer program called "DeedMapper." These deeds gave few directions or distances. They read "with the new road" or "down the meanders of the Nap of Reeds Creek." Some of the directions given were obviously not correct But there were enough lines that were right to connect them with other deeds already in place - deeds I am positive are in the right place.

By using the lines I knew were right, drawing others that corresponded to other known correctly placed deeds, and drawing the "meander" line down the creek, a composite plot of the land sold by William Jones, Jr. was drawn. This property appears to be just West of the present State Hospital and North of the old Veazey cemetery.

On 6 Oct 1831, Moses Jones, Jr. sold all his land "on the East side of Nap of Reeds Creek" to Albert Sneed for \$800. Probably the reason for Moses Jones, Jr. selling all of his property at this time was that his in-laws, Benjamin and Winifred (Turner) Wheeler, had both died by that time (between the time the 1830 census was taken and 6 Oct 1831). There wag; a migration of Wheeler family members to several Middle Tennessee counties about this time. (It is possible that a large group of southwest Granville Co. residents migrated together as there were quite a number of Granville Co. surnames on the 1840 Middle Tennessee counties censuses.) Moses Jones was in Bedford Co., Tenn. when the 1840 census was taken. There were no elderly people in his household at that time.

It was several miles from Moses Jones' property on Nap of Reeds Creek to the "Indian Grave Hill" cemetery. There are three possible sites for the graves of Benjamin Wheeler, Sr. and his wife Winifred. Two of them are the Moses Jones "home place", marked on the map on the following page, and the Indian Grave Hill site. The third site is the old Wheeler cemetery that was moved in 1997. All the known graves at that site have been identified.

On the map you can compare the distance between where Benjamin Wheeler, Sr. had lived, and in 1830 belonged to Benjamin Wheeler, Jr., and where Moses Jones, Jr. lived. I do not know how things were done in those days but I would not think they would carry a body 5-6 miles to bury them [back to where they had lived previously] when there was a more convenient cemetery 2-3 miles away. It is likely that Benjamin Wheeler and his wife, Winifred Turner, were buried either on Moses Jones "home place" or in the cemetery on Indian Grave Hill. We'll probably never know.


